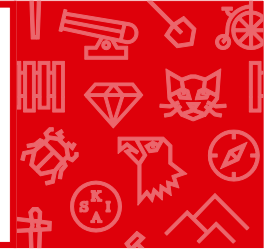


## Victorian Women

...Explore history through the eyes of Keswick's women

### Session Outline

The session concentrates on the stories of four women who lived in Keswick during the Victorian period, which offer a varied insight into Victorian life. The children will discover different perspectives and aspects of life in the past from the viewpoint of wealthy and poor women. If you want to find out more, come to Keswick Museum.

Three activities complement one another to help the students to uncover Keswick's Victorian past.

- **Discover the exhibition's reconstructed room sets.** Immerse yourself in the Victorian past, and investigate the stories of real Keswick women.
- **Explore Victorian costumes** to further enhance the experience, with an opportunity to dress in replica clothing.
- **Examine Victorian objects** in a handling session.

Each student receives an explorer booklet to take home.

### Practical Details

- Year groups 3-6
- The three activities take 2 hours
- The students work together in pairs and groups of three or four
- 10am-12pm or 1pm-3pm
- £2.50 per pupil, leaders free
- Lunch possible on site if booked in advance
- There is also an opportunity for a guided walk to visit the Keswick Yards area. Please ask for further details
